One source of nonpartisan candidate information is the League's voter guide on VOTE411.org, where voters can read candidates' answers — if they responded — to the League's questionnaires. At VOTE 411, voters can compare candidates' responses, which are posted verbatim, and find the candidates that best fit their values.

"VOTE411 is an easily accessible, comprehensive resource for voters who want reliable information about voting in Wisconsin," said Linda Bjella, co-president of LWV Appleton-Fox Cities. "Tens of thousands of Wisconsin voters — including many young people and first-time voters — rely on VOTE411 as their go-to source for unbiased candidate information."

In addition to the voter guide on VOTE411.org, the League of Women Voters of Wisconsin (LWVWI) website has information on voting including what to bring to the polls, early and absentee voting information, and more, available in both [English](#) and [Spanish](#).

"We know voters are busy. That's why the League provides voters with these easy-to-access resources so they are fully prepared to cast their ballot," Bjella said. "The League encourages voters to make a plan to vote, visit VOTE411.org, and remind others to vote on August 9."
