LWV Appleton Partners with K-C's LAND Network on Program

APPLETON, WI — League of Women Voters of Appleton with the collaboration of Kimberly-Clark's LAND (Latin American Network for Diversity) will host a virtual informational program celebrating Hispanic Heritage on Monday, October 19 from 5:00 to 6:30 p.m. The terms Hispanic, Latino, and Latinx designate the largest ethnic minority group in the US, covering many cultures and peoples. In the United States race matters because our social structures have made it matter throughout US history, its policies, and actions.

The program will foster understanding of Social and Climate Justice among Hispanics in Wisconsin. Guest speaker Norys Piña, one of the most active Latina advocates in the Fox Valley, will address the social realities of Hispanics in the area, and the impact of Climate Change among vulnerable Hispanics.
