Mental Health Care Position - 2008

The Board of Directors of the Appleton League of Women Voters recommends the adoption of the following position statement at the Annual Meeting, May 15, 2008

LWV- Appleton supports:

mental health care system which is community based and includes financial and geographic accessibility for residents of all ages. This system should include same day service availability and immediate care options for all. This system should be adequately staffed in both the in-patient and out-patient care arenas insuring that no person in need of services would be turned away or made to wait. Appropriate on-going, affordable treatment options for all persons should be available regardless of one's ability to pay.

mental health system where care is coordinated between the providers of services to persons who are publicly insured, privately insured and uninsured. Coordination should exist between primary health providers, mental health providers, pharmaceutical providers and public and private insurers. Providers should share all treatment options with each individual and assure that each person understands his or her options for care.

mental health system in which all providers have knowledge of the complete delivery system in the community so that all people get adequate treatment or are referred to other providers to receive appropriate care.

mental health system in which referrals between private, non-profit and for-profit providers are utilized to ensure the best overall patient care and least duplication within the mental health delivery system.

mental health crisis care system that is responsive, well staffed and adequately supported.

This position will be included in the Social Policy section of our Local Support Positions (2006). It will be added as a new Roman Numeral seven (VII) on page 12 with all following position statements being renumbered appropriately to the end of the Social Policy section.


