President's Corner

fter the annual meeting on May 15, 2008, the Board determined we needed to meet over the summer months. A planning meeting was held June 4 at which Board meetings were scheduled for June 10, July 8, and August 12, 2008. Minutes of Board meetings can be found on our website. The decision to continue meeting over the summer months is based on a number of upcoming events: the upcoming elections, our chance to enroll in and receive "Special Registration Deputy Training" allowing us to register voters statewide, actual registration of voters by LWV-Appleton members, the Joyce Foundation Grant to hold a forum on judicial rights with the Neenah-Menasha League, and a request by the Neenah-Menasha League of Women Voters to explore a possible future merger with our Appleton League. LWV-Appleton has received a request by the LWV Neenah-Menasha for a possible merger and suggesting a name change to LWV Fox Cities. The reasons given for a merger were outlined by Judith Anseth, LWV-Green Bay and Wisconsin, on behalf of LWV Neenah-Menasha,

and include: membership in the LWV Neenah-Menasha has been dropping, a merger would provide greater unification aligning League with many other Fox Cities with either Appleton, Neenah, or Menasha, financial support from businesses that identify with the whole region, not an individual town or city, and increased media coverage by radio and TV stations that refer to the area as Fox Cities.

At the June 10 Board meeting, a motion was made, seconded and passed to: "study the request of the LWV Neenah-Menasha to merge with the LWV Appleton and to change the name to the LWV Fox Cities." To this end, a committee has been established to study the pros and cons of such a merger and name change and to get more details of the LWV-Neenah-Menasha expectations. This committee, chaired by Winnie Doxsie, includes Shirley Strange, Stevie Schmidt, and Carolyn Mewhorter. The first committee meeting was held June 24, 2008. A second meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, July 22, 2008 at 7:00 pm at the home of Winnie Doxsie, 1708 North Hall Street, Appleton. All interested LWV-Appleton members are invited to attend. A General Membership meeting on the merger will be scheduled later this summer. Please contact Winnie with any questions, ideas, and/or concerns. Great Lakes Compact Signed into Law!

Yesterday was historic! Gov. Jim Doyle, surrounded by legislators, civic leaders, media, and citizens, signed the Great Lakes Compact into Wisconsin law!

What does this mean for Wisconsin?

<u>It means that</u> Wisconsin joins Minnesota, Illinois, Indiana, and New York as the 5th state to pass the Compact through its legislature. (For updates on the status of the bill in the remaining three states, <u>click here</u>.)

<u>It means that</u> Wisconsin has taken the necessary steps to protect the Great Lakes for future generations, including our lake-dependent economies.

<u>It means that</u> Wisconsin *citizens* played an ENORMOUS role in the passage of this bill:

- Over 700 citizens attended Conservation Lobby Day 2007 & 2008, and asked their legislators to pass the Strong Great Lakes Compact!
- In March, over 150 citizens turned out to a Senate hearing in Kenosha with just 24 hours notice!
- And, over the last two years, **over 5000 citizens** have contacted their legislators through post-cards, emails, and phone calls!


