Our work plan for this year includes:

Regular and intentional outreach
Being visible in the community and establishing a year-round presence
Identifying and engaging new leaders

The Appleton League has been especially visible in the community in the past months. We had our Equality Day Luncheon, Movie Night, 57th Assemble Candidate Forum, Public Forum, 8th Congressional Candidate Forum, and our President's presentations at community meetings. These were all opportunities to display league materials, welcome people, and invite individuals to join.
