Purpose

The purpose of Birth-Five Outreach is to identify and connect with parents of children ages 0-5 who reside within the Appleton Area School District.

Funding

Birth-Five Resource Coordinator positions are funded solely through the Appleton Area School District. Parent/Child Playgroups, Fun in the Sun Park Days, Parent Resource Libraries, and Parent Workshops offered throughout the target schools are funded through the AASD as well as local and state grants.

How is Birth-Five different than Birth to 3?

Birth-Five focuses on outreach to all families with children five and under who are not currently enrolled in kindergarten, and who reside within the Appleton Area School District.

The Birth to 3 Programs focus on identifying and supporting children ages 0-3 who have delays in their development. Children receiving support and services through Birth to 3 have met the eligibility of a 25% delay in development or atypical development,

or have a diagnosis likely to lead to a developmental delay.
