VOTER INFORMATION

The information below will help you answer questions like "How do I register to vote?", "Why should I vote?" and "How do I figure out who to vote for?"

WHO CAN VOTE IN WISCONSIN?

You can vote in the state of Wisconsin if you are:

- A U.S. Citizen
- 18 years old
- At your current residence for 10 consecutive days
- Not on parole



HOW DO I REGISTER TO VOTE?

To register to vote online, go to: myvote.wi.gov (<http://myvote.wi.gov>)

You will need a current Wisconsin driver's license or state issued ID to register to vote.

- *The address on your ID needs to be current.*
 - *If the address is not current, the site will direct you to the DMV. You can change the address online at the DMV and return to myvote.wi.gov (<http://myvote.wi.gov>)*

Once you are ready, click on *Register to Vote* at myvote.wi.gov (<http://myvote.wi.gov>).

- Answer the questions on each screen. At the end there will be a document indicating you are registered.

WHAT IF I DON'T HAVE A WISCONSIN LICENSE OR ID?

You can fill out a paper registration form [here](https://elections.wi.gov/forms/el-131-fillable) (<https://elections.wi.gov/forms/el-131-fillable>).

This completed form needs to be mailed in with proof of residence, such as a copy of your utility bill, or brought in person to the clerk's office.

WHAT KIND OF ID DO I NEED AT THE POLLING PLACE?



A current WI driver's license/ID or passport (*the address does not need to be current*).

HOW DO I FIGURE OUT WHO TO VOTE FOR?

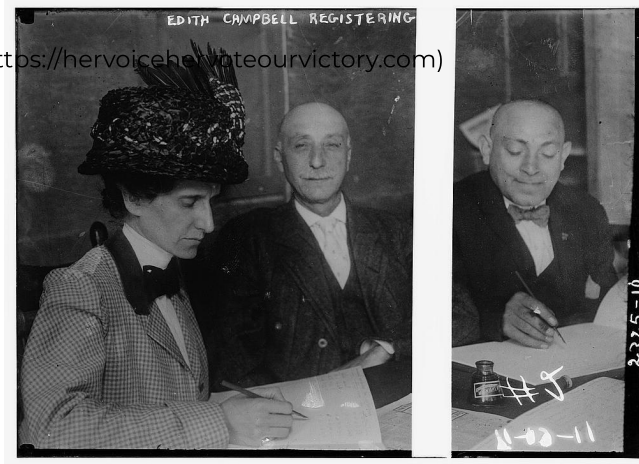

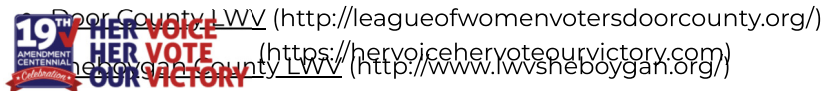
WHY SHOULD I VOTE?
