# VOTER INFORMATION

The information below will help you answer questions like "How do I register to vote?", "Why should I vote?" and "How do I figure out who to vote for?"

# WHO CAN VOTE IN WISCONSIN?

You can vote in the state of Wisconsin if you are:

- A U.S. Citizen
- 18 years old
- At your current residence for 10 consecutive days
- Not on parole





#### To register to vote online, go to: myvote.wi.gov (http://myvote.wi.gov)

You will need a current Wisconsin driver's license or state issued ID to register to vote.

- The address on your ID needs to be current.
  - If the address is not current, the site will direct you to the DMV. You can change the address online at the DMV and return to myvote.wi.gov (http://myvote.wi.gov)

Once you are ready, click on Register to Vote at myvote.wi.gov (http://myvote.wi.gov).

 Answer the questions on each screen. At the end there will be a document indicating you are registered.

# WHAT IF I DON'T HAVE A WISCONSIN LICENSE OR ID?

You can fill out a paper registration form <a href="here">here</a> (https://elections.wi.gov/forms/el-131-fillable).

This completed form needs to be mailed in with proof of residence, such as a copy of your utility bill, or brought in person to the clerk's office.

# WHAT KIND OF ID DO I (https://hervoicehervoteourvictory.com) NEED AT THE POLLING PLACE?



A current WI driver's license/ID or passport (the address does not need to be current).

## HOW DO I FIGURE OUT WHO TO VOTE FOR?

Look for non-partisan sources for information such as VOTE411 (https://www.vote411.org/). This site has questions sent to all candidates with their responses side by side so you can evaluate their stance. Also, attend you local League of Women Voters (https://www.lwv.org/) events.


